Natural Play and Intimate Play Spaces

Our Focus

- The creation of 'Jen's Kids Farm', which will include large plant boxes, compost, gardening tools, watering cans, a sensory area and maybe a scarecrow!
- Provide our Children the opportunity to manage 'Jen's Kids Farm',
 everything from ordering materials to planting and nurturing the farm.
 Through play our Children can explore, learn and develop a true
 appreciation for their surrounding environment.
 - Introduction of intimate play spaces using of plants and natural materials, indoors and out, where our Children can feel 'hidden' in their own special place. Whilst also being able to take responsibility for their own environment.



Staff Mentoring and Support
